Fire Board Meeting

March 24, 2011

January minutes approved.

Chief Larry Waddle stated that the permitting process is in final stages for dry hydrants. Ron Farrell has contracted with a surveyor to construct plans of the critical areas at the dry hydrant sites.

Chief Larry Waddle stated that preparedness notifications were updated on all Town Employees.

A RFP will go out this month for the purchase of the air cascade system. Iris Hill, Town Administrator, suggested that Chief Waddle contact Chief Barry McRoy with Colleton County EMS to see if they wanted to co-purchase an air cascade system with the Edisto Beach Fire Department to save money. Also RFP will go out for the extrication tools, the garage doors and operator and gutters for the fire department building. A new generator is needed to insure the repeater will work during emergency operations.

Repairs at the Fire Department are moving forward.

The Reserve Academy classes are expected to be completed by the middle of May 2011.

The Fish Fry committee met last Friday to start organizing. The FD will set up tents on May 26, 2011.

The Emergency management meeting was held at Litchfield Resort and was very informative.

Starting in May the fire trucks will go to Colleton County for maintenance.

Chief Waddle stated that his 2011 budget is completed and on in-code program.
