Tropical Storm Debby Update #2 - 8/05/24

Town Operations have moved to OPCON 2 along with Colleton County.

Weather Conditions

The most significant threat posed by the storm is extreme rainfall and flooding, with predictions of 20-30 inches by this Friday. Additionally, a storm surge of 2-4 feet is expected. We are currently under a *Tropical Storm Warning*, *Flood Watch*, *Storm Surge Warning*, and *High Risk for Rip Currents*.

- Travel: Plan your travel accordingly this week due to expected statewide flooding.
